The first LOGOS gathering at King of Glory Lutheran Church in Billings, Montana, was held in 1993. Church leadership was interested in the mid-week, cross-generational aspects of this new ministry for our church. LOGOS was well received from the very beginning. Children and adults enjoyed the different parts of LOGOS and the relationships being built.

Challenges and growing pains occurred through the years. We experimented with the inclusion of different grades and different Wednesday times. For the past several years we have successfully settled on offering LOGOS to Grades 2 through 6 on Wednesdays from 5:00 - 7:00 p.m.

LOGOS has become an important piece of our Christian education program. We believe that relationships with God, peers, and adults are being strengthened each and every week. Kids love so many parts of the evening together: dressing up for the fun themes and parading around for our weekly fashion show, singing fun and energetic songs

together, learning during Bible study, playing games together, creating meaningful projects, eating great food (!), plus joining in on fun and silly parts of Family Time.



With four sessions completed so far this school year, our favorite LOGOS time by far has been "Knight Night." We were transported back to medieval times. The kids found awesome knight, princess, and wizard costumes - many in anticipation of Halloween approaching. They raided dollar stores and thrift stores. Our weekly fashion show was one of the best we have ever had! During Recreation Play each child created a personal coat of arms on a corrugated cardboard shield. The kids learned about many Christian symbols and included those on their shields. We ate with our hands during dinner (no utensils)! It was a fantastic evening together.



We look forward to LOGOS each week. Many, many volunteers make it possible. Kids and adults alike are enriched and blessed each time we come together. Thanks be to God!
