## LOGOS 2009 YOUTH CONFERENCE INFORMATION

### **Purpose**

The purpose of these weeklong national gatherings is to bring together our larger LOGOS family for a unique experience, which, on a daily basis, faithfully integrates the four essential parts of the LOGOS ministry that are typically shared in the local church setting. Ultimately the mission of these conferences is to nurture young people into discipleship through Christian relationships.

### **Adult Leadership**

The LOGOS Youth Conferences are built upon the close relationship of adults working with youth. These conferences are not ones where van drivers "dump" kids at the campgrounds and then have no responsibility until the conference is over. As in a local LOGOS ministry, the relationship between youth and adults is essential. Adults will be sharing in leadership at the conference as Bible Leaders, Activity Leaders, and Room Counselors. Therefore, you need to bring one adult for every four youth. If your delegation includes male and female youth, you should also have male and female adult leaders. Young adults (18-21 year olds) will serve in adult leadership roles as appropriate. It is the responsibility of the local congregation to call qualified adults into conference leadership. The "Pastor Endorsement Form" assures the Conference Director that the adults attending understand their roles and meet the high standards of leadership for LOGOS.

The Church Registration Form asks for the name of the leader of your delegation. **This is the person traveling with your group and in charge of your group.** Further communication will be made with this person. The conference staff will confer with the delegation leader regarding any problems or concerns involving a member of your delegation.

### **Facilities**

Conference West is held at the YMCA of the Rockies Estes Park Center. Lodging is in dorms. Youth will be housed in a room with four other people. Accommodations include bedding, linens, and towels and bath facility. Roommates will be from different congregations, and where possible from different states. We try to house youth of the same grade level together. An adult is Room Leader for each youth room. Adults not serving as Room Leaders will be housed together. Meals are served buffet style in the YMCA dining hall. Special dietary needs are the responsibility of the individual.

Conference East is held on a college campus. Lodging is in dorms, usually arranged in suites of three two-person rooms. Accommodations include bedding, linens, and towels and bath facilities.

Roommates will be from different congregations, and where possible from different states. We try to house youth of the same grade level together. Adults will serve as Room Leaders for each suite. Meals are served in the Campus Dining facility. Special dietary needs are the responsibility of the individual.

## **Schedule**

Registration will begin late Sunday afternoon. You will be notified of the exact time in a confirmation letter. The conference begins with the evening meal on Sunday. The last event is closing worship and communion on Friday night. Adult room counselors are responsible for their rooms on Friday night. The conference officially ends at **6:00 A. M. Saturday. Please do not plan to leave before 6:00 A. M. Saturday**

Each day participants will experience the four parts of a LOGOS ministry. Bible Study Groups are small age-level groups. Recreation/Activity hour provides a wide variety of choices to experience fun and relationships. Worship Skills is experienced as the whole conference gathers together as the Conference Choir preparing music for the Friday Communion Service. Family Time/ Holy Hilarity is experienced either at meals or after dinner. Special all-conference events are held each evening. The afternoons are provided as an opportunity for church groups to have time together.

A more detailed daily schedule for each conference will be included in confirmation mailing when you register.

## **Medical Forms**

A medical authorization is included with the registration forms. This medical form is essential: **youth will not be allowed to remain at the conference without this form.** This form does **not** have to be notarized. We suggest you make two copies for each minor coming in your delegation. Keep one for your travel; turn in the other at registration.

## **Discipline Policy**

All behaviors at the LOGOS Conference are guided by our shared theological understanding of treating one another as children of God. We believe, therefore, that no one has the right to treat anyone else as if they do not matter. The implications for our life together at conference are that we constantly respect one another, our surroundings, and ourselves. According to these theological guidelines Delegation Leaders, the Deans, and the Director will deal with inappropriate behavior.

## **Regarding Children**

The LOGOS Conference is planned and held for high school youth and the adults working with them. The conference program does not include activities or care for underage children. If it is absolutely necessary for parents to bring children, they must arrange for the supervision of their children.



## LOGOS 2009 YOUTH CONFERENCE REGISTRATION INFORMATION

1. **Hold an Informational Meeting** with everyone who has any interest in attending the LOGOS Youth Conference: youth, adults and parents of youth planning to attend. At that meeting review the purpose of the conference, the expectations, and the registration process.
2. **Extend a call to adults** to the ministry of the Conference. Adults who attend Conference will serve in leadership roles. Provide each adult with the following (included in this packet): Adult Roles and Responsibilities, Expectations of Adults, Adult Registration Form.
3. **Complete Pastor Endorsement Form.** It is necessary for the person serving as head of the church staff to complete the form that provides information about adults attending the LOGOS Youth Conference.
4. **Complete a Registration Form for each person attending.** Every registration form must be signed by the person named on the form and, in the case of youth, by the parent or guardian.
5. **Complete the Church Registration form.**

**It is essential for the planning of the conference that registration forms for adults and youth are sent to the Conference Managers when registering. Leadership for the conference is called from the adults who register. The Bible Groups, Rooms, and Activities are assigned by name and grade. This process cannot be completed until the names of all those attending are received.**

**After submitting registration forms, the Delegation Leader will receive a confirmation letter from the Conference Manager with specific information about the conference daily schedule and specific needs, All further communication about conference should be directed to the Conference Manager.**

## Fees and Deadlines

The Registration Fee includes meals, room, and program materials.

**Registrations received after APRIL 15, 2009 are accepted only if space is available and must be accompanied by a \$150/person deposit.**

It is essential for the planning of the LOGOS Youth Conference that registrations be received by April 15<sup>th</sup>. Leadership for the Conference is called from the adults who register. The Bible Groups, Rooms, and Activities are assigned by name and grade.

This process cannot be completed until the names of all those attending are received.

**Final payment.** Payment in full must be made by all churches (including first-time attenders) and received by the LOGOS Ministry by **June 1, 2009**; payments received after June 1, 2009 will be assessed a late fee of \$100/church. **All registrations must be paid in full by July 1, 2009.**

**Cancellations.** Cancellations must be made before June 1, 2009 to receive a full refund. Cancellations made after June 1, 2009 and up to 7 days before the Conference will receive a refund minus the deposit. Cancellations made less than 7 days before the start of Conference will forfeit the total registration fee.

**PLEASE NOTE: Cancellations and changes are official only by calling The LOGOS Ministry at [toll free] 877-937-2572.** The LOGOS Ministry Office will notify the Conference Manager of any cancellations or changes in your delegation.

## ADULT ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES FOR LOGOS 2009 YOUTH CONFERENCE

All adults at the LOGOS Youth Conference serve in leadership roles. As in all local LOGOS ministries, the prime qualifications for leadership are

*Love God*  
*Love Youth*  
*Have a gift to share*

Adults are expected to treat all youth as if they were their own youth, seeking to form relationships and encourage and guide them during this week into a deeper life of discipleship.

Adults are called to the following areas of leadership:

### **Bible Study Leader/Assistant**

- Bible Study Curriculum will be provided before conference for leaders
- Student materials will be included in conference notebook
- Be faithful in preparing and teaching the material provided.
- Bible Groups will be about 12 youth of the same grade level.

### **Room Leader**

- Supervise dorm room group of 4-6 youth.
- Lead "Talk it Over Time" at end of day to reflect on the day's experience.
- Help young people abide by conference rules for the dorms - lights out, quiet times, being good caretakers of facilities
- Make sure all have arrived to first event of the day

### **Activity Leaders**

- Follow the goal of Activity time: "Have great fun at the expense of no one else."
- Supervise an activity emphasizing *Child of God* behavior
- Provide a safe physical and emotional environment.

#### *Sporting events leaders*

Organize teams in such a way that everyone is valued.  
Be responsible for care of equipment that is provided.

#### *Table Game/Card Games Leaders*

Bring various board/card games of interest for youth.  
Encourage everyone to participate and build relationships.

#### *Craft Activities Leaders*

Plan for various crafts and provide materials.  
(Expenses will be reimbursed when receipts are submitted)  
Lead activity.

#### *Guitar Leader*

Facilitate opportunity for youth to share skills.  
It may be necessary to divide group into those who are beginners and those who are more advanced.

#### *Drama, Sign Language, Drumming Group Leaders*

Provide materials and opportunities for youth to experience various forms of drama-choral reading, speakers' choir, short skits; signing for songs; drumming. In consultation with Conference Director/Worship Leader some of these materials may be shared in worship experiences.

## Expectations of Adults Attending the LOGOS 2009 Conference West

The LOGOS Conference operates on the same principles as your local LOGOS Ministry: adults are called into leadership because:

- they love God,
- they love youth,
- and they have gifts to share.

As an adult coming with youth delegates, you are asked to make a covenant with the conference to abide by all the rules and expectations and assist in providing leadership to the conference.

There are **three primary roles** you fill as an adult:

- First, you provide an example to the young people modeling the LOGOS principles of loving, Christ-like relationships.
- Second, if asked, you assist as a room counselor.
- Third, you share your gifts in an area of leadership as called by the conference staff. This might include working with an activity, Bible group, or other needs.

**Regarding leadership by young adults (ages 18-21).** We value the talents and gifts that our "LOGOS Graduates" bring to conference leadership! We also realize that it is sometimes difficult to move from "camper" to "counselor."

To provide the best experience for both the leaders and the participants at conference we recommend the following guidelines for young adult leaders:

- For those who have attended conference as a high school youth, there should be a break of one summer before returning as an adult leader.
- The local church has provided guidance in the transition from participant to adult leader.

### The Rules for Everyone

The LOGOS Youth Conferences are national gatherings of youth and adults involved in local LOGOS ministries. The purpose of our time together is to celebrate the oneness we have in Jesus Christ and to share in a week of the LOGOS experience. This week provides us the opportunity to draw closer to God and to one another as we form new relationships and reunite with old friends. It is a time of inspiration and worship, fun and recreation, study and personal growth.

## LOGOS 2009 Conference West Code of Behavior

*We will treat one another as Children of God.  
No one has the right to treat others as if they do not matter.*

While we are together at the conference, we are a community. All communities require rules to protect the rights of the individual and to ensure the best possible experience for all. The following rules will be followed by every person attending the conference:

1. **You will always treat everyone at the LOGOS Youth Conference as a *Child of God*, and you have the right to expect to be treated this way also at all times.**
2. **You will be in full attendance at each activity on the planned schedule of the day.**
3. **You will only be permitted to enter other rooms when invited by the occupants. However, entering rooms of the opposite sex is never permitted.**
4. **You may not leave the grounds except as part of a scheduled LOGOS Youth Conference activity.**
5. **The use of cell phones during scheduled activities will not be permitted. Cell phone use is only permitted during free time and before lights out.** It is the responsibility of delegation leaders to enforce this policy. If for some reason the use of a cell phone by a youth is deemed necessary, this must be cleared with the Conference Director prior to the Conference.
6. **Smoking and the use of tobacco at The LOGOS Youth Conference will not be permitted.**
7. **The bringing, holding, or use of alcohol, drugs (including tobacco and other than those for which you have a prescription), weapons, or explosives is forbidden.**

***Please note: Any request for an exception to these rules must be made to and approved by the Conference Director prior to the Conference.***
