**Myrtle Beach Church Launches LOGOS**

We have two weeks under our belt, and what fabulous weeks they have been! We have started our inaugural year of LOGOS here at First Presbyterian Church in Myrtle Beach with 60 registered participants, grades 1-5, and already we're growing. We have two dozen table hosts, six kitchen crews, five Youth Assistants, five sets of Bible leaders, two recreation leaders, oodles of other volunteers and one excited church family!



Wednesday afternoon, the kids will pour in at 4:00, sporting their new LOGOS t-shirts, and half will swarm on up to choir, while the others enjoy recreation. After 45 minutes, they'll switch places. Then it is down to the Fellowship Hall for Family Time. Tonight, two volunteers are downstairs cooking spaghetti sauce for a hundred, so it can stew in the seasonings and be at its best for dinner Wednesday. It will be Polite Night, and our Associate Pastor Chris Denny will be our tuxedoed Dinner Dean. Four guest readers will be on hand to read the hysterical and appropriate book, *Do Unto Otters*, as part of our Recreation Play. The "proper way" to mind your manners while spoon hanging is on the agenda for our intergenerational fun.

After dinner, Bible Time wraps up the evening. We have had to divide our 2nd graders into two groups, since we have twenty children in that grade level alone. At the close of their time together, the Bible leaders escort their students to our portico, where the Pick-Up Crew puts them into their parents' cars, who have been waiting in line.

Comments parents have shared from their children include: "Why do we have LOGOS only on Wednesday?" And "It is so cool, Mom! I have Winston Warner's parents for my Table Hosts!" (Winston is a way cool high schooler who is one of our student assistants.) One senior Table Host complained today that "We just don't get enough time with our children!" and another couple said they were so happy Sunday when one of their group stopped to wave good bye to them before leaving for Children's Church.



We know we will have many opportunities to grow and make changes, yet we look forward to learning together. After two years of prayerful preparation, the enthusiasm

and joy with which LOGOS has started thrills me. Thank you all for this ministry, for sharing your decades of experience, your energy, your delight in what you have seen God do through LOGOS in other congregations. Thank you for the prayers you continue to send up for all the LOGOS congregations, as we do for you in turn.

God is so good, and we celebrate how we are already growing closer as God's children here through LOGOS.
